

Pedigree of the Bewleys of Woodhall, Baitcliffe Hall, and Beguil, Cumberland,

EXCLUDING THE DESCENDANTS OF JOSEPH BEWLEY, OF HESKET, AND MUNGO BEWLEY, OF EDENDERRY, DEALT WITH IN SEPARATE PEDIGRES.

(In continuation of Pedigree A.)

MATTHEW BEWLEY, of Woodhall, in the parish of Caldbeck, named in a Master Roll, 1699, Hen. VIII, amongst those manured at Caldbeck, and named in Survey of the Wharfedale Manors of 15 Jan. 1560, as holding one-fourth of the demesne lands of Woodhall in the Manor of Caldbeck, by customary freehold tenure.

THOMAS BEWLEY, of Woodhall, admitted tenant of one-fourth part of the demesne lands of Woodhall in 1588; a witness to the will of George Bewley, of Woodhall, in 1598.

GEORGE BEWLEY, of Woodhall, named as son of Thomas Bewley in house contained in Court Rolls of 16 Oct. 1555, and as a tenant of one of the divisions of Woodhall in Survey of the Wharfedale Manors of May, 1611, named in Subsidy Rolls of 1644 and 1661; a party to deed of a September, 1613, commencing arbitrary fines in the Manor of Caldbeck; described as Woodhall in will dated 8 July, 1643, which was proved at Caldbeck.

THOMAS BEWLEY, of Halcroft Hall and Woodhall; named 'DOKOTRY' in his father's will, and appointed an executor; bought lands of 1601; named in Halcroft Hall in 1641, and both Halcroft Hall in 1653; a witness to the will of George Fox; presented and inspected for non-payment of tithes; a. cov. 1595; Nov. 11 Dec. 1680, at Wharfedale, near Caldbeck (Cumb. F. R.).

WILLIAM BEWLEY, of Dookery Hall, Penrith; Elizabeth, dau. of ———, of Penrith, 23 Jan. 1636 (Pen. F. R.).

GEORGE BEWLEY, of Penrith; MARGARET RAY or RAYNE, dau. of ———, of Penrith, 15 Feb. 1662, as widow of George Bewley (Pen. F. R.).

MUNGO BEWLEY, of Iwiggill, named in his father's will, and appointed an executor; named in Free Bencroft (named in will of her husband, and also in will of her father, dated 15 June, 1640).

JANE, dau. of Thomas Storchy, named in will of her father, dated 15 June, 1640.
